About Us:

Ala Costa's Adult Transition program is a non-profit organization which serves intellectually/developmentally disabled adults ages 18 years and older from the Berkeley Unified School District, North Region SELPA and Regional Centers. We are a community-based program that focuses on self-determination, vocational and independent living skills, and community integration.

Job Description: Community Facilitator

Adult Program Community Facilitators instruct creatively and intentionally in a community-based adult transition and adult day program for people with disabilities. We are an organization that is committed to disability justice and the right of disabled people to have equal access to the community and make their own choices.

Job Responsibilities:

Encompass instruction in areas of independent living skills [i.e. cooking, money management, travel training. etc.], community integration, and vocational skills. Our overarching goal is to decrease dependence while learning in the least restrictive environment. Prospective employees believe in the importance of the concepts of self-determination, person-centered programming, and student agency. Ongoing training is provided in all of these areas.

Qualifications:

- Must be able to work without direct supervision
- Ability to read and write effectively
- At least 18 years of age
- Ability to be First Aid/CPR certified
- Fully Covid-19 Vaccinated

- \$19.50 per hour starting pay, plus excellent benefits.
